

He picked up a handful of gravel and mud, washed the mud from his hand and found something that took him completely by surprise. Gold!

The mining of precious ores - on the Krahbergzinken, for example - transformed Schladming in the period from the 13th to the 15th centuries

### Mausi's Styrian cheese recipe:

Add salt and pepper to 1 kg of low-fat quark and mix well. the quark a little in the sieve and leave for 1-2 days. Place the quark onto a cloth and leave in a warm place for a few days (until cracks develo Then lay a damp cloth over it and put it in a cool place.

Turn daily for 4-6 weeks until it turns a grey-brown
