





The summit of the Stoderzinken can be reached from the car park in 45-60 minutes via the summit trail. Alternatively, you can also get to the summit from the Friedenskicherl via the Florasteig (free from giddiness and sure-footed).

The starting point of the hike is the car park at Gasthof Dachsteinruhe (closed) on the Styrian-Salzburg border between Filzmoos and Ramsau. On foot or by shuttle bus (runs every half-hour from 08:30 a.m. to noon and from 01:00 to 05:00 p.m.), along the alpine lane to the marmot meadow on the Schaidlalm below the Bachlalm hut. Then it goes from the Schaidlalm on trail no. 671 in an easterly direction to Marboden. From the easy hiking trail, you are constantly treated to impressive views of the steep

rockfaces of the Dachstein. Through a sparse larch forest, we continue from Marboden to the huts of the Neustattalm and along the Dachstein road to the Glös-Alm. After a forest path through a brief wooded area, you come to the Luxwiese, where you meet the Duregg trail (No. 8). After a last look at the impressive three-pronged peaks of the Torstein-Mitterspitz-Dachstein, you will follow the narrow alpine path down to the Dachsteinruhe, the original starting point.

Trautenfels Castle is enthroned on a rocky outcropping at the foot of the Grimming. It was here that a castle by the name of Neuhaus was first mentioned in 1261. In the 17^{th} century, the building was remodeled by Count Siegmund Friedrich von Trauttmansdorff in the style of the Baroque. The high-quality frescoes were created by Carpoforo Tencalla, the stucco work by Alessandro Sereni. Since the structure underwent thorough rehabilitation work in 1992, visitors are also surprised by modern architectural elements in the midst of this historic building. The regional heritage museum housed at Trautenfels Castle presents the cultural and natural history of the Styrian Ennstal and Ausseerland regions in a series of 13 kaleidoscope-like rooms. The lookout tower, open to the public, affords broad views across the alpine world of the Ennstal. Accessible to people with mobility limitations and those with learning disabilities.

SPECIAL EXHIBITION 2022 The Healing Arts The History of Medicine

The healing arts are rooted in the maintenance of good health and the healing of illnesses and injuries. This exhibition project provides an overview ranging from medicine in antiquity to folk medicine and monastic medicine, from plagues over the course of history to modern medical techniques. This interdisciplinary exhibit also addresses medical care on the regional level within Styria, with particular focus on the Liezen district from the year 1700 to the 21st century. - Medieval Schloss Großsölk was in the hands of the nobility until it was taken over by the Jesuits. Today, this historic treasure is used by Naturpark Sölktäler as a museum, with several exhibitions on display.

The Jesuit Garden in the courtyard and in front of Schloss Großsölk is used for educational purposes as well as pure enjoyment. Growing here in addition to flowers are many different medicinal and kitchen herbs, along with ancient almost-forgotten vegetable varieties. These gardens may also be visited outside of regular opening times.



DO YOU ALREADY KNOW...? in Forstau

PATH OF ST. LEONHARD - LOURDES CHAPEL



The Path of St. Leonhard begins at the cathedral in Salzburg and ends in St. Leonhard outside Tamsweg, though it also leads through Forstau. The parish church in Forstau (built 1742) is likewise consecrated to St. Leonhard. At the bottom of a short pathway, we come to the Lourdes Chapel. This chapel on the banks of the Forstaubach commemorates the visions of the Virgin Mary and the miraculous healings associated with Lourdes, the famous pilgrimage destination in France. Its most striking feature is a grotto with stalactites. In part,

they were brought here especially from France, while the rest originated in the Forstau area adjacent to the Oberhüttensee. A Madonna in Neo-Baroque style, which could be positively identified as a Lourdes figure, is embedded in the stone grotto.

The chapel has remained unchanged since it was established. In 2004, the Lourdes Chapel was designated as a listed monument. The chapel is open to all interested visitors.

Terms @ Conditions

The following conditions are expressly stipulated for the issuance and use of the

PREAMBLE

The Schladming-Dachstein Sommercard (hereinafter referred to as: Sommercard) en-titles Guests of the Schladming-Dachstein Region, who are staying during Sommer-card season at a Sommercard host business and who have registered by means of the official Guest registration form, to take advantage of many bonus services as well as free admission to over 100 holiday attractions, including summer lifts, swimming pools and museums as well as use of participating public transportation in the region and an exciting family program.

The purchase, issuance and utilization of the Sommercard – insofar as not stipulated otherwise – is subject exclusively to the following Terms & Conditions (hereinafter referred to as: Terms).

To facilitate comprehension, these Terms avoid gender-specific formulations to the greatest extent possible. Insofar as any gender-specific terminology happens to be used, the intent is that this applies to all genders.

1. LEGAL SCOPE OF THESE TERMS & CONDITIONS

These Terms apply to the contractual relationship between the operators of the Sommercard and Sommercard holders and – insofar as nothing is stipulated to the contrary below - represent the exclusive legal foundation for issuance and utilization of the Sommercard. Divergent provisions are not recognized by the operators of the Sommercard and may not, therefore, constitute part of the contract. These Terms may be found on the website of Schladming-Dachstein Tourismusmarketing GmbH at https://www.schladming-dachstein.at/de/Service/Impressum, from where they may also be saved or printed off.

2. OPERATORS OF THE SOMMERCARD

The operators of the Sommercard are ARGE Schladming-Dachstein service providers as well as Schladming-Dachstein Tourismusmarketing GmbH, which may be reached by means of the following contact channels: Tel.: +43 (o) 3687 23310

3. PURCHASE AND ISSUANCE OF THE SOMMERCARD

The conclusion of an accommodation agreement with a host Sommercard business (refer to website) entitles the contractual partner and their travel companions (Guest) to avail themselves of the Sommercard. (The contractual relationship between the Guest and the Sommercard host – with the exception of provisions pertaining specifically to the Sommercard – is unaffected by the Terms at hand.)

A requirement for issuance of the Sommercard is that the Guest – in accordance with official registration regulations - has truthfully reported their personal data to the host Sommercard business.

Regardless of the length of stay, the Sommercard host is required to draw the Guest's attention to the Sommercard. The Sommercard host will issue the Guest with a physical or digital Sommercard. The physical Sommercard only becomes valid subsequent to the Guest having signed the back of the card. The digital Sommercard is valid as soon as it has been activated by means of the Sommercard app (hereinafter referred to as: app) on the Guest's smart phone. In order for the digital card to be issued (without a physical card), the Guest must provide the Sommercard host with an email address to which the Sommercard host can then send a link for the digital card.

The Guest is likewise entitled to install the app on their (mobile) device, then use the scan function to convert and subsequently use the physical card as a digital

The Sommercard may only be used for utilization of Sommercard services by that person whose name and identification number is given on the card (the legitimate holder). With respect to the digital Sommercard, it is possible to store the cards of several people on the same end device. However, each respective digital Sommercard may only be utilized by the legitimate holder in question.

The Sommercard is nontransferable and is not available for purchase on the open market (only as a season ticket).

4. VALIDITY OF THE SOMMERCARD

The general validity period of the Sommercard extends from 20 May until 1 November 2022.

The specific validity of a Sommercard is restricted to the dates of the stay stipulated in the accommodation agreement entered into between the Guest and the Sommercard host in question. Validity begins at 1 PM on arrival day, while the card remains valid for all of the remaining days including departure day.

5. SCOPE OF SOMMERCARD SERVICES

The Sommercard entitles the holder to utilize specified Sommercard services according to the Sommercard conditions as detailed. The specified Sommercard services as well as the detailed Sommercard conditions may be consulted at www. sommercard.info - this information is nonbinding. With the exception of the specific conditions, the respective tariff conditions of the Sommercard service provider in question will apply.

When utilizing Sommercard services, the respective general terms of carriage and business, access restrictions, capacity restrictions and hours of operation of the Som-mercard partner business will apply. Furthermore, utilization of Sommercard services may be adversely affected by additional waiting periods or cancellations due to weather, seasonal or miscellaneous operational reasons. Liability on the part of the Sommercard operator for such limitations of service is excluded.

6. UTILIZATION OF SOMMERCARD SERVICES

In order to utilize a specific Sommercard service, the physical or digital Sommercard must be presented to the Sommercard service provider whose Sommercard services are about to be utilized, prior to concluding the contract entitling the cardholder to utilization of said Sommercard services. The Sommercard service provider is entitled to check the validity of the Sommercard by means of an electronic verification device, visual inspection etc. If the Sommercard service provider has any doubts about the validity of the Sommercard or the holder's entitlement to use the Sommercard in question, the provider may demand presentation of photo identification as proof. If the Sommercard is not presented, if it is not or no longer valid, or if the holder refuses to show it, the Sommercard service provider is entitled to deny conclusion of a con-tract for the Sommercard service in question according to the conditions originally associated with the Sommercard.

7. MISUSE, LOSS, THEFT OF THE SOMMERCARD

The Schladming-Dachstein Sommercard is nontransferable. The legitimate holder must ensure that the Sommercard is not misused. Misuse includes in particular the illegitimate utilization of Sommercard services under Sommercard-specific conditions, duplication of the Sommercard or use of the Sommercard by third-parties. The at-tempt to transfer a Sommercard to a different person constitutes misuse per se. In the event of misuse, loss, theft or other misplacement of the Sommercard, the legitimate holder must notify the Sommercard operator by telephone or email or the Sommercard-Gastgeber host without delay. The Sommercard operator is not liable for the consequences of damages due either to complete failure or culpable delay in noti-fying the Sommercard operator about the misuse, loss, theft or other misplacement of the Sommercard – subject to Pt. 8. of these Terms. Misuse will be penalized by confiscation without replacement of the Sommercard and a fine of at least € 70, or by official complaint lodged with the appropriate authorities.

With respect to loss, theft or other misplacement of the physical Sommercard, the legitimate holder has the right to issuance of a new Sommercard.

8. LIABILITY

Terms & Conditions

The holder of the Sommercard is aware that the sole responsibility of the operator of the Sommercard is for processing procedures between the legitimate holder and the Sommercard service providers as well as Sommercard hosts. The legitimate holders relinquish any potential guarantee or damage claims against the operators, regardless of whether the service provider or Sommercard host is accused of a negligent breach or not. Liability on the part of the operator for damages due to slight negligence with respect to breaches of secondary obligations is excluded. In the event of negligent breaches with respect to primary obligations, the operator is not liable for damages the cause of which, by dint of their general nature, appear completely incommensurate with such damages, or for damages which are merely the result of an extraordi-nary chain of circumstances. Liability on the part of the operator for premeditation, gross negligence as well as damages resulting from culpable injury to life, body or health of people shall remain unaffected by the aforementioned provisions.

The operator is not the contractual partner of the legitimate holder when utilizing Sommercard services. That said, the operator is not liable with respect to any claims deriving from the contractual relationship between the legitimate holder and the Sommercard service provider in question. In particular, the operator is not liable for denied, non-provided or inadequate (Sommercard-)services rendered by a Sommer-card service provider, for damages resulting from the legitimate holder (or his/her companions) utilizing Sommercard services, nor for those services listed as Sommer-card services under https://www.schladming-dachstein.at/de/Sommer/Sommercard#Sommercard-Attraktionen or in the Sommercard brochure not being offered by the service providers in accordance with the described Sommercard conditions.

9. DATA PRIVACY

The safeguarding of personal privacy and personally identifiable data of the Sommercard user is a special priority of the operator. Consequently, personally identifiable data is processed exclusively on the foundation of statutory provisions (Regulation [EU] 2016/679 for the protection of natural persons pertinent to the processing of personally identifiable data, free movement of data, and repeal of directive 95/46/EEC [GDPR], Data Privacy Act 2018 ["DSG 2018"] and the Telecommunication Act 2003 ["TKG 2003"]).

Consent to these Terms simultaneously confirms awareness of the Data Privacy Policy.

10. AMENDMENTS TO THE TERMS

Amendments to the Terms come into immediate effect. The exception to this are Sommercards which are valid at the point in time when the amendment comes into effect. These continue to be subject to – with the following exceptions – the Terms in their most recent valid version prior to purchase of the Sommercard.

The operator may undertake minimal, objectively justifiable amendments to these Terms consistent with \S 6 (a) (3) KSchG unilaterally at any time. These amendments may include, in particular: extension of the validity period, editorial adaptations and stylistic changes. Sommercard users will be provided notification of unilateral amendments to these Terms at the Internet address https://www.schladming-dachstein.at/de/Service/Impressum and potentially also by email.

11. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

Should individual provisions of these Terms – including this particular provision – be declared null or void, either completely or in part, or if the agreement evinces an unforeseen loophole, this shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining provisions. In place of a voided or absent provision, insofar as no compelling legal regulations demand the contrary, this agreement will be amended by means of a provision which most closely approximates the commercial and contextual purposes of the original provision in question.

12. APPLICABLE LAW

Insofar as no compelling statutory regulations demand the contrary, the applicability of Austrian substantive law under exclusion of international civil law as well as the UN Sales Convention shall be stipulated.

13. SEAT OF JURISDICTION

Insofar as no compelling statutory regulations demand the contrary, the international jurisdiction of the Austrian courts as well as the competent courts – at the point in time when suit was brought – with local jurisdiction over the seat of Schladming-Dachstein Tourismusmarketing GmbH shall be stipulated.

14. SOMMERCARD SEASON PASSES

Offshoots of the Schladming-Dachstein Sommercard for guests, there are various other cards which are valid for the entire Sommercard season: the Vermieterkarte, Freizeitcard, employee- and benefit cards. These passes deviate in their included services and specific conditions from those of the Sommercard for guests. The aforementioned terms are, however, applicable to all seasonal cards with the exception of the validity period and purchase conditions.
